#### Important Notes - Please Read Carefully

- The tournament organizer reserves the right to restrict or combine draws and/or age categories depending on the quantity of entries received.
- The preferred competition format for this event will be 'knockout draws' with 'plate' competitions. 'Round Robin' formats will be used if numbers dictate. Draw types are subject to change at the discretion of the Tournament Organiser. All formats will be dependent on entries received.
- All players must enter the 'plate' if they lose their first match in round one or two.
- Entries will not be accepted without payment or if they are received after the closing date.
- Refunds will not be given for withdrawals after the closing date.
- Competitors must be <u>under</u> the relevant age for their group on 13<sup>th</sup> November 2016.
- Competitors may only enter one event.
- Receipt of your entry will be confirmed by e-mail. Please contact the organiser if you do not receive this.
- Registration times for each age group will be posted on our website <a href="www.stortfordsquash.co.uk">www.stortfordsquash.co.uk</a> and e-mailed to participants during the week preceding the tournament.
- ESR approved eye protection must be worn for all matches.
- All players must wear clothing suitable for squash.
- Parents must refrain from interference in matches. Any complaints should be addressed formally to the Tournament Desk.
- All competitors (or their parents) will be expected to mark and referee the next match on the court
  they have just vacated. They should not wait to be chased.
- All matches will be PAR to 11, best of 3 games.
- Competitors must report to the Tournament Desk at least 25 minutes before their first match.
- Seeding will be done by England Squash.
- During the event, photographs or recorded images may be taken for internal display purposes, newspaper articles and the Club's website. If you do not want this to happen for yourself, please advise the tournament organiser.
- The England Squash Code of Conduct will apply.
- All finalists are requested to attend any presentations following the finals.
- ESR Membership is compulsory for all players wishing to compete in Sanctioned Events (except players who do not compete outside their county of residence)

Current England Squash disciplinary procedures will be enforced for this tournament. Withdrawal from the tournament (including withdrawals from the plate) must be notified to the organiser as soon as possible by telephone with a valid reason. Your reason for withdrawal should then be confirmed in writing to England Squash within 7 days and, in the event of illness or injury should be accompanied by a letter of explanation (from parent or coach if juniors) or medical certificate.
